SAMNIC is a transnational project, funded under the EU Erasmus+ Programme, to develop and implement a MOOC – a Massive Open Online Course – on the Safety Assessment and Management for New and Innovative Children's Products. The MOOC is targeted principally at industry (especially SMEs) and consumer organisations.

SAMNIC MOOC is an online free Internet course to which almost everyone can register; it has practically an unlimited number of participants.

The SAMNIC MOOC is expected to be ready in August 2016 and will be available in English, Spanish, French, Italian, Czech and Portuguese. It will be accessible through PCs, tablets and smartphones

Event in Ibi (Alicante)

Last 18th May an information event about European project SAMNIC was held at the facilities of the Technological Institute of Children's Products and Leisure (AIJU), in Ibi (Alicante), Spain.

Event in Prague

Last 20th April an information event about European project SAMNIC was held at the facilities of the Czech Association for Toy and Play (SHH) in Prague. The event was aimed primarily at technical staff in the industry and consumer associations, and aimed to spread the open and free online course which is being developed under project SAMNIC and continue the process of attracting potential validators for Czech version of the platform.

During the event, the speakers highlighted the advantages offered by this online tool to improve the skills of the organizations involved in children's products safety; some of the training contents developed under the project were shown. The presentations covered both the perspective of the industry (SHH) and of consumer (ANEC); among others the subjects, the concept of 'MOOC' was discussed and how to take benefit from online learning, as well as the role of standards in children's products safety, the value of safety for the industry, the hazards in children's products and how the application of methodologies of risk assessment can improve the safety of products.

>is it totally for free?

SAMNIC MOOC is a course 100% for free for everybody.

>what do I need to take this course?

You can take the course using your computer, tablet or smartphone. You just need access to the Internet!

>what does SAMNIC MOOC offer?

SAMNIC MOOC offers a global vision about children's products safety. This course is perfect as a first approach towards children's products safety, as it will give you a broad perspective of all the aspects to take into account when we talk about products used by children, no matter if you are a designer, engineer, architect, purchasing manager, distributor, quality technician or if you work in the public administration (consumption) or if you are in charge of the playground areas of your town or city. Besides, the platform developed will give you the change to get in contact and exchange knowledge other people involved in child safety. Thanks to SAMNIC MOOC, you will be part of a multidisciplinary network of professionals.

>what am I going to learn?

After the course, among other things, you will be able to assess the risks associated to the design of your product, detect the most important risks and propose measures to reduce the risk; you will know how to search for and choose the applicable safety standards for your product and you will learn the key aspects of children (motor skills, cognitive development...) to bear in mind when designing products.

>what is the timetable?

SAMNIC MOOC has no timetables, you can learn whenever and wherever you want. It will be available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

>when does it start?

The platform of the course is currently being developed by the partners of the project, but we are creating the potential group of users in Spain, Belgium, Italy, the Czech Republic and Portugal that will be able to participate in the pilot phase of SAMNIC MOOC before being launched. The course will be available for all users at the end of October 2016.

>will I get a certificate when the course ends?

When the course is over, you will be able to download your digital certificate for free. SAMNIC MOOC offers customised paths depending on your interests. For example, if you are a quality technician or a designer in a toy company, you will have a customised route adapted to your needs, or for other professional profiles in the same way. All these routes have their own certificate.
